Miami's baseball team got one of its rare victories over Florida State, a 6-4 decision, here yesterday.

The two clubs were scheduled to go at it again today, 3:30. Righthander Larry Hawkins (2-1) was to start on the mound for the Seminoles.

It was the first time in nine tries the Hurricanes had been able to beat FSU in baseball. Yesterday marked Miami's fourth victory in 25 games with FSU, its first since 1958.

FSU had one more hit than Miami, but a 4 - run sixth by the visitors did its damage.

Miami third baseman Bobby Ward collected three hits in four trips to pace the Hurricane attack. Larry Wilson went 2-for-4 and Harvey Foster was 2-for-5.

George Fergusson went 2-for-3 for the Seminoles, Shortstop Woody Woodward collected a single in the ninth to run his total to 27 hits in 14 consecutive games.

In Miami's big sixth, Chico Deliz led off with a walk: Wilson followed with a single and rightfielder Jay Kotzen drew a walk. Leftfielder George Bell struck out, but Ward's single to center scored Deliz and Wilson, Foster singled to right scoring Kotzen.

Allen Thomas relieved for FSU at this point, but Elmer Harris' fielder's choice scored Ward. Danny Understahl grounded out to end the inning.

Miami picked up single runs in the third and ninth.

FSU scored one run in each of the third, fourth, fifth and ninth.

In the ninth after one was out, Bob Madison was hit by Heffer. Billy Williamson singled to left and Woodward hit a routine fly to right that fell harmlessly between righfielder Jay Kotzen and second baseman Ernie Yaroshuk for a single.

With the bases loaded, Kyle Spitzer scored Madison on a sacrice fly, but Buddy Teagle's fly to right ended the game with the tying run on first.
