

Ida State's baseball team fought its way to a 3-1 victory over Duke here yesterday.

The same two clubs were scheduled to meet again this afternoon. FSU stands 10-7. Duke is 8-7-1 for the year.

Allen Thomas packed up the victory for FSU. He is 2-1 for the year. Ray McShane relieved in the seventh, gave up one hit the rest of the way.

Bob Fergusson went 2-for-3 to lead Seminole batters. He also scored a run, drove in another.

Bob Madison and Hal Mangin went 2-for-4. Both scored runs and Mangin had one RBI.

FSU picked up a single run in the sixth, seventh and eighth. Duke got its lone score in the second inning.

In the seventh, Madison singled. Bill Williamson followed to left, then Mangin hit Madison home.

In the seventh, Fergusson walked. Larry Johnson sacrificed him to second. Mike Augustine brought in Fergusson with a single to right.

After Mangin singled to left in the eighth, Buddy Teagle reached first on an error, then Fergusson brought him home.

For the first time in 17 games, FSU's ace sophomore shortstop Woody Woodward failed to hit safely.
