

Densmore got himself into the 9th-inning predicament when Bob Madison singled to right, Bill Williamson and Woody Woodward walked.

The victory was Duke's ninth of the season against seven losses and a tie. FSU, 10-8 for the year, had beaten Duke on Friday.

Bob Rankin led the Blue Devils' hitting forces with two safeties in as many trips. Rex McKinley and Dave Uible also stroked a pair of hits apiece. One of Uible's was a double.

Other than Teagle and Mangin, Madison and Bob Fergusson collected two hits each for FSU.

Starter Larry Hawkins absorbed the loss, his second against two victories. Bob Turner (2-0) was the winner. Reliever Densmore, normally a starter, is 5-1.

FSU pushed across a single run in the fourth when Williamson led off with a single. Mangin produced another hit, and Fergusson knocked Williamson in with one to left.

Duke collected three runs in the first, though Hawkins struck out the first two batters he faced. Brooks Fader got a base on balls, and successive singles by Rankin, Uible, McKinley and Ken Stallings did the damage.

Hawkins got into trouble in the third, when Rankin rapped a leadoff single. FSU second baseman Larry Johnson dropped a double play ball and Rankin and Uible were safe. Then Hawkins struck out McKinley and Stallings, but Dave Mueller walked to load the bases. Walks to Turner and Bucky Fader forced in two runs, before Jack Ross' relief put out the fires.

The Seminoles go to Chapel Hill for a doubleheader with North Carolina and East Carolina tomorrow. They play a single game with North Carolina State at Raleigh on Tuesday, move to Statesboro, Ga., for a game with Georgia Southern on Wednesday. Then take a rest until May 11.
