

RALEIGH, N. C. — Florida State's baseball team, behind many record breaking performances, handled North Carolina State, 12-3, here yesterday.

The Seminoles completed five double plays which brought their total to 28 for the season, tying the school record set by last year's team.

FSU batters blasted seven doubles, bringing that season's school mark. Seminole catcher Buddy Teagle stroked a pair of the 2-baggers, his ninth and tenth of the year, to break the old record of nine in a season, set by Bob Trowbridge in 1952 and equaled by Neil Martin in 1959.

Madison and Teagle went 3-for-5 at the plate. Bob Wilcox went 4-for-6.

Florida State, now standing 12-9 for the year, was scheduled to go against Georgia Southern in Statesboro today. North Carolina State has a 6-5 record.

After today's game, the Seminoles are idle until May 11, when they take on Florida Southern in Tallahassee.
