STATESBORO, Ga. Florida State's baseball team got its third straight route - going pitching performance as it downed Georgia Southern, 5-1, here yesterday.

Senior lefthander Jack Ross stopped the Eagles on eight scattered hits in winning his second game without a defeat. The Seminoles collected 10 hits off two righthanders, including Billy Williamson's 6th home run of the season. The towering drive equal led a Tribe record for home runs in one season.

The record is shared by Fred Twomey (1955) and Tallahassee's Jack Dull (1959). Tuesday the Seminoles set a home run recordfor a Tribe team in one season.

FSU also set a double play record in the win over the Southerners. The Tribe fielders collected their 29th double play of the season in the first inning when, with the bases loaded and one out, Ross fielded a high bouncer from the bat of leftfielder Charles Finely, threw home to catcher Buddy Teagle and Teagle in turn doubled Finley at first with a perfect throw to first baseman Hal Mangin. The old record was set last season.

The Tribe got off to an early lead in the second inning when Woody Woodward and William-

son received walks from pitcher E. G. Meybohm. Teagle singled to deep short and with two out Ross helped his own cause with an infield single, driving in Woodward.

Williamson's home run proved to be the winning run as the leftfielder blasted a Meybohm curve ball over the left field fence.

The Seminoles added three more in the 8th on three singles, an error and a wild pitch.

The Eagles scored an unearned run in the bottom of the eighth on a single, double and an FSU error.
