

Florida State's baseball team sought a second straight victory over Florida Southern here this afternoon after trimming the Moccasins, 9 - 7, here yesterday.

The Seminoles slapped out three homers among nine hits, and twice came from behind.

Big blow was Hal Mangin's 4-run homer in the bottom of the fifth, after Southern had gone ahead, 6 - 4.

Southern got off to a swift start with three runs in the first. Bill Holt's bases-loaded single brought in two. Then Holt and Rick Duncan worked a double-steal, with Duncan scoring.

The Seminoles got a run in the bottom of the inning on Bob Madison's homer, his fifth of the season. Two more came in the third when Ray McShane walked and Bob Wilcox homered. It was Wilcox's first four-bagger.

FSU went ahead, 4-3, on a run in the fourth, wrought by Mangin's double and Buddy Teagle's single.

Southern then erupted for three in the fifth, with Darrell Fulton's homer bringing in two. A double and a single scored a third.

Two walks and an interference call on catcher Fulton against Woody Woodward loaded the bases for FSU in the fifth. Then up stepped Mangin with his home-run shot.

Both teams added single runs, FSU in the sixth and Southern in the ninth.

It was FSU's fourth straight victory and the fourth straight time a Seminole pitcher has gone the route. McShane picked up his fifth victory against three

losses, struck out 12. FSU is now 4-9 for the season, Southern 12-11.

After meeting the Mocs today, the Seminoles get ready to close their regular season next week, with Georgia Southern here Monday and Tuesday, two final games at Florida on Friday and Saturday.
