

The big bats of Al Beccaccio and Bill Williamson paved Florida State's 8-2 baseball victory over Georgia Southern here yesterday.

The victory was the Seminoles' sixth in seven games and avenged a Monday loss to the Eagles. FSU is 16-10 for the year. Southern stands 13-7.

The Southern players' bus was involved in a wreck on Highway 27 north of Killearn Gardens on the return trip. No players were reported injured.

Williamson swatted a 2-run homer in the first inning — his eighth of the year. He had broken a school record with his seventh the day before.

Williamson also clouted a double down the third base line off the glove of Southern first baseman Kenny Kline, scoring Beccaccio in the fifth.

Beccaccio was 3-for-4. He also smashed a home run in the third inning with one on. He scored three runs.
