

**GAINESVILLE** — Florida used four unearned runs in the eighth inning to break a 5-5 deadlock and win a 9-5 decision over Florida State's baseball team here yesterday.

The loss put the Seminoles' record at 16-11 for the year. The two clubs were scheduled to clash again at 2 o'clock this afternoon.

The fatal eighth came with two outs. Earl Montgomery, former Blountstown ace, bounced one off Allen Thomas' glove. Catcher Len Scheinhoff drew a walk and Bernie Haskins was due to next.

Florida Coach Dave Fuller put in left-hand hitter Ed Brady, so FSU Coach Danny Litwhiler put in Jack Ross, a lefty. Fuller took out Brady, put in Charley Bean, a righthand hitter.

Bean hit a fly ball to Bob Wilcox in left field. Lost in the sun, it bounced out of his glove and Montgomery scored.

Walks to Ron Birchall and Don Ringgold forced in a run. First baseman Bob Coleman singled to center driving in two more.

Bill Williamson went 2-for-3 for FSU. Gary Elliott was 2-for-4.
