

GAINESVILLE — Pitcher Larry Hawkins cuffed Florida batters for better than seven innings and led Florida State's baseball team to a 6-2 victory here yesterday.

Hawkins (3-2) yielded five hits during his 7 1-3 innings. Reliever Tommy Davis gave up only one. All the Gators' hits were singles.

The victory brought FSU's record to 17-11 and avenged a Friday defeat to Florida. The Gators, Southeastern Conference champion, finished with a 25-8 mark, are headed for the Regional NCAA

tournament.

Bill Williamson collected two hits in four trips, including a double, broke the school record for number of hits in a season with 45. The old record of 44 was set by Bob Clem in 1959.

The team record of 302 hits in a single season, set last year, was bettered by five. Mike Augustine and Woody Woodward both went 2-for-4 at the plate for the winners.

The Tribe, which gave up four unearned runs in the eighth inning Friday, played errorless ball yesterday.

Al Beccaccio doubled home a pair of runs in the third inning.

Mike Augustine had singled in a score previously.

The Seminoles picked up another run in the fourth on Hal Mangin's sacrifice fly, pushed across two more when Florida catcher Len Scheinhoff threw wild to second on a steal attempt and George Roundtree singled to left.

Carol Lanoux got two of Florida's hits.
