

Florida State's hopes for an undefeated season were cast aside yesterday afternoon as the Clemson Tigers blasted the Seminoles, 12-7.

A total of 8 players were used by FSU coaches, with FSU leading the way with 21. Coach Danny Litwhiler gave the fans a look at his pitching staff as he used eight of the 11 pitchers listed on the Seminole roster.

At the plate Clemson was led by Jonny Jones, a senior from Orlando, and Pete Ayoub. Both of them accounted for a total of six hits and four RBI's. Going all the way for the Tigers on the mound was sophomore left - hander Tommy Chapman.

Chapman was never in real trouble as he spaced FSU's 14 hits evenly over his nine inning tour. He walked six and struck out four.

Loading the way for the Seminoles was junior center fielder Mike Augustine of Philadelphia,

Pa. Augustine collected three hits and scored the first Seminole run. He also turned in the game's finest fielding play as he went deep in center to haul down a 400 foot drive off the bat of Jones.

Larry Johnson who came in for injured third baseman Jerry Chmielewski did yeoman duty at the plate in hanging out a double and a single in three attempts.

Chmielewski received a split lip in fielding a throw from right fielder Woody Litwhiler in the inning. The cut required three stitches, but he will be back in the lineup tomorrow.

Losing pitcher Gary Williamson was plagued by two costly errors and his inability to get the ball over the plate.

The Seminole record now stands 3-1, while Clemson is 1-1. The two teams met again today in the first game of a triple header at Seminole Field. At 12:30 Clemson tangled with Navy, and the Seminoles met the Middies at 3:30.
