

Florida State's baseball team enjoined Navy and Clemson in a tripleheader Saturday at Seminole Field, and when The Longest Day was over nine hours later the Seminoles had split a pair of games and gone 4-2 for the year.

FSU defeated Clemson 12-3 in the first game—which began at 10 p.m.

FSU lost to Navy 8-7 in the second game—called due to darkness at 6:55 p.m.

And in between, Clemson battered Navy 17-4.

From here, the Seminoles travel to Auburn for single games on Monday and Tuesday. Their next home games come April 5-6, against Furman.

FSU's biggest gun during the day was little Centerfielder Mike Augustine, who clubbed six hits in ten trips and made a pair of sparkling catches. Seminole Catcher Buddy Teagle slammed a bases

loaded homer early in the morning game to ease the way toward FSU's 12-3 win over Clemson.

Clemson had moved to a 3-1 lead over FSU before Teagle unloaded his second homer of the young season. The Seminoles scored five in the third, four in the seventh and coasted in behind the six-hit pitching of Allen Thomas, who allowed only two earned runs over his seven innings.
