loaded homer carly in the morning game to ease the way toward FSU's 12-3 win over Clemson.

Clemson had moved to a 3-1 lead over FSU before Teagle un loaded his second homer of the young season. The Seminoles scored five in the third, four in the seventh and coasted in behind the six-hit pitching of Allen Thomas, who allowed only two earned runs over his seven innings.
