

AUBURN, Ala.—Buddy Teagle, Florida State's All-America catcher, slammed a two-run triple to left field in the sixth inning to give hurler Al Beccaccio all the cushion he needed as the Seminoles defeated Auburn 5-1 Monday afternoon.

It was FSU's third straight win over Auburn this season, also the third in a row for Beccaccio. The Seminoles are now 5-2 overall. Auburn is 2-3 overall, and 2-0 in Southeastern Conference competition.

Beccaccio, a 6-2, 195 -- pound right-hander, held Auburn hitless until the fifth inning, when catcher Bill Turberville singled to right. The Tigers outhit FSU four to three. However, two errors and two walks accounted for four of the runners who scored for the Seminoles.

Sophomore Jimmy Crysel, who threw only six pitches to get credit for the win over Georgia Saturday, was the loser. He gave up only three hits while walking five and striking out four in seven innings.

Florida State scored in the first inning as Crysel walked lead-off hitter Jim Reed. Mike Augustine followed with a single past first baseman Larry Dempsey to send Reed to third. Reed then came home on a sacrifice fly by Gary Nichols.

Crysel pitched hitless ball until the sixth. Nichols went to second on a two-base outfield error by Dink Haire. Woody Woodward worked Crysel for a walk before Teagle slapped his triple to left, scoring both runners.

Teagle's hit was a line drive which bounced over the head of left fielder Mailon Kent and rolled to the fence.

Auburn spoiled Beccaccio's shut out in the eighth inning. Tandy Gerald, pinch-hitting for relief pitcher Jerry Lewter, opened the inning with a line single to left. Jimmy Barfield, drove in the Tigers only run, but was thrown

~~out trying to stretch his hit into a triple.~~

Augustine had two of FSU's three hits and Teagle the other. Three of Auburn's hits were by pinch-hitters Gerald, Richard Seaman and Barfield.

Auburn and FSU will conclude the two-game series here this afternoon. Both coaches were undecided as to whom they would pitch.
