

Unloading for nine runs over the last two innings, Florida State's baseball team ripped out a 13-3 decision over Furman here yesterday as Righthander Allen Thomas of Cairo, Ga. posted his fifth straight win of the young season.

The victory left FSU 9-3 for the year. They were to gun for No. 10 today at 1:30 against Furman.

Big stickers for the Seminoles in a 14-hit attack against three pitchers were second baseman Jim Reed, rightfielder Gary Nichols and shortstop Woody Woodward.

Reed reached base all five times he came to bat, three times on singles and twice on walks. Nichols busted three singles and Woodward — in a slump of late — smacked a 360-foot homer with one mate aboard in the eighth inning.

Two other Seminoles — third baseman Larry Johnson and centerfielder Mike Augustine — had two hits.

Thomas had only one shaky inning — the second, when Furman scored all its runs. The lanky senior yielded seven hits, only

two earned runs and fanned seven before Coach Danny Litwhiler let soph Robert Kull mop up in the ninth.

Thomas and Righthander Al Beccaccio have now recorded all nine Seminole victories this year, and the duo hasn't lost a verdict yet.

Only Paladin with more than one hit was first baseman Bob Rasmussen, who collected a single and a double. The loser for Furman was starter Dennis Hennett.
