

STATESBORO, Ga. (AP)—Back-to-back home runs in the third inning by Gary Nichols and Woody Woodward helped the Florida State Seminoles defeat Georgia Southern 10-8 in baseball Saturday.

Florida State led 8-1 after 4½ innings, but the Eagles almost pulled it out when they sent 10 batters to the plate and scored six runs in their half of the inning.

The big blow of Georgia Southern's rally was a bases-loaded double by catcher Sandy Wells.
