

RALEIGH, N. C.—North Carolina State struggled to an 11th inning victory over Florida State's baseball team 8-7 Wednesday, with shortstop Larry Clary's sharp single to right field driving in the winning run.

FSU's Billy Williamson had sent the game into extra innings with a two run homer in the top of the ninth, before the Wolfpack bounced back to win its fifth straight victory over non-Atlantic Coast opponents.

Warren Lineberger, the ACC's No. 1 hitter, got his second hit of the day to open up the 11th inning rally. He made it to second on a sacrifice. Clary then singled on a 2-2 pitch, and a good slide

by Lineberger beat catcher Buddy Teagle's tag at the plate.

Both starting pitchers, Gary Williamson and George Allen, got off to rough starts, with North Carolina getting three runs in the first and FSU bringing in four in the sixth.

"Woody Woodward (shortstop) played a sensational fielding game," FSU Coach Danny Lit-

whiler, "it kept us in the game."
