

Pitcher Al Beccaccio had himself a day—both on the mound and at the plate—as Florida State's baseball team beat Georgia Southern 10-6 here Monday.

He belted his pitching mark to 2-1, going the route, striking out four, granting four walks, and eight hits. He picked up two hits — one a home run — in four times to the plate and drove in three runs.

It was FSU's second victory of the season over the Georgians, and upped Coach Danny Litwhiler's nine to a 16-8 record. Southern is now 17-9. The two were scheduled to go at it again here this afternoon, 3:30.

The game got going after a 45 - minute delay by showers cooled things off.

FSU scored in the first inning. Jim Reed singled, reached third on Mike Augustine's sacri-

fice bunt. Reed scored on a fielder's choice and an error. Shortstop Woody Woodward whacked a double to send Nichols home.

Southern came back big in the second. Sandy Wells, Charles Tarpley and Denny Kline rapped back - to - back singles to load the bases. Pitcher Pierce Blanchard walked, forcing Wells home. Tommy Jones' single scored Tarpley, and Kline came home on an error by Woodward.

The next scoring came in the bottom of the third, when Augustine led with a home run to knot things at 3-3. FSU went ahead when Woodward walked, advanced to third on Dave Dahlen's single, and made home on George Roundtree's fielder's choice.

A lone run in the fourth came when Beccaccio belted his homer.

Tarpley slammed a three-run homer for the Georgians in the top of the fifth. FSU retaliated in its half of that inning, when Dahlen cracked the day's fourth home run. Roundtree and Jim Loftin followed with singles, each advanced on an infield out, than were driven home by Beccaccio's single.

The final scoring came when Dahlen singled, scored on Roundtree's home run in FSU's half of the sixth.
