The Bulldogs had gone ahead in the first inning, when a single by Carroll Minick, two bases on balls, and Torn Reid's sacrifice fly produced one run. In the

third inning, Georgia added its final two runs on a single by Reid, two walks and an error.

Singles by Ken Suarez, Buddy
Teagle and Jim Reed loaded the
bases for the Seminoles in the
eight. With one out to go, Dave
Dahlen whacked a single to bring
two runners home.

Bill William's home run got the Tribe going in the ninth, and knotted things at 3-3. Jim Loftin cracked a single, went to second
