Daryl Lowe drove in three runs for Tennessee, collecting three hits. Ken Hudgens went 3-6, driving in one run and scoring one. Jack Ervin drove in one run with two hits. Dewey Thompson, one of Tennessee's stalwarts, was blanked 0-3.

Vol starter Jim Axon had control trouble, walking 12 in two innings. The Seminoles jumped out to a 7-2 lead and shelled reliefer Hal Leffew for five more runs in the third inning.

Leffew settled down and limited Florida State to three runs the rest of the way.

Lowe walloped a home run and Hudgens tripled for the Vols.
