

Righthander Cliff Ranew struck out 13 batters, and shortstop Larry Johnson hit his third home run in as many games as Florida State shut out Georgia Tech, 5-0, in baseball at Seminole Field yesterday.

Ranew, a 6-5 graduate of Norman Park (Ga.) Junior College and the brother of Chicago Cubs catcher Meritt Ranew, walked only two men, and allowed only eight to reach first base in a four-hit performance for his second victory.

Johnson, who had only four extra-base hits enroute to a .272 batting average last season, blasted his third home run of this season, chasing Gary Nichols home ahead of him. He also lifted a Texas Leaguer in the fifth inning which fell between three Tech fielders for a double.

In the eighth inning Ranew and Jim Reed hit singles, and

Mike Augustine loaded the sacks on an error by second baseman Doug Cook. Ranew scored on a wild pitch by Tech hurler Jimmy Robinson and Bob Wilcox's single cleaned the bases.

Frank Hall started for Georgia Tech, playing its first game of the year, and was lifted in favor of Robinson after the fourth though he had given up only two hits. Hall allowed four hits. Yellow Jacket pitchers struck out three and walked one batter.

Center fielder Doug Harris singled twice for the Jackets, who were able to piece hits together only in the seventh inning when third baseman Ter-

ry Hall, a defensive wizard, singled along with Harris.

Ranew struck out at least one batter in every inning.

The Seminoles meet Tech again this afternoon at 3:30. Righthander Bob Kull will start for FSU.
