

STATESBORO, Ga.—Florida State's up and down Seminoles made five costly errors, allowing Georgia Southern six unearned runs and an 8-6 upset victory here Friday.

Even more upsetting than the loss to Coach Fred Hatfield was an injury to Cliff Ranew, the Seminoles' undefeated pitcher. Ranew had a car door slammed on the thumb of his pitching hand. The injury is reported to be minor, however, and Ranew should be ready to pitch against Miami Tuesday.

Florida State got fourteen hits off two Southern pitchers, but left ten runners stranded.

Georgia Southern got five big runs in the second inning on errors by Larry Johnson and

Jim Reed. The Georgians added one in the sixth and two in the eighth.

The Seminoles got two in their half of the second when Gary Williamson, the losing pitcher, doubled with two aboard.

Gerry Chmielewski homered in the sixth and made several outstanding plays at third base for Florida State.

All FSU runs were earned.

Williamson lost his first game in two starts. He was relieved by Bob Kull in the fourth, and Ken Creely pitched the ninth, giving up his second earned run in 24 1-3 innings.

Leftlander Don Murray will start today in the second game of the series. The loss leaves the Seminoles with a 17-7 season record. It was their third loss against two wins on the current road trip.
