

Florida State buried Wake Forest and Duke under an avalanche of base hits Saturday to close out the FSU Invitational Baseball Tournament on a winning note.

In a morning game, Michigan State shut out Wake Forest, 6-0 giving them a tie for first place in tourney standings. Both FSU and Michigan State finished 6-3. Wake Forest was 3-4, and Duke, 0-7.

The Seminoles exploded for seven runs in the eighth inning to come from behind to defeat Duke in the first game of a split doubleheader.

Duke, a hard-luck team all notched two runs in the top of the eighth to break a 2-2 tie, but Florida State's bats were warm, and the Seminoles batted around in their half.

Mike Martin and Tom Thomas led off with back to back singles, then Pete Sarron, who broke a long slump in a spectacular way yesterday, ripped a double to right center bringing in Martin. Monty McBryde got his third single of the day and an RBI driving Thomas across.

A walk to pinch hitter Dean Duchak sacrifice fly by Randy Brown, and a wild pitch got two more across, then Dick Fernandez went for the pine trees with his third round tripper of the year, bringing three more across.

The Seminoles other two runs came in the first inning on a single by Fernandez, a double by Maury Hopkins, a sacrifice fly by Thomas and another double by Sarron.

FSU had a two run lead behind pitcher Jim Ward going into the fourth inning of the Wake Forest game when Seminole power began to wreak havoc on Deacon pitcher Pascal Renn.

With one out, Hopkins poled one over the right center field fence. Martin singled but was forced by Brown for the second

out, but the hot-handed Thomas picked things up with a single.

Sarron towered one which followed approximately the same route as Hopkins' earlier drive and the Seminoles had a six run lead.

Sarron and Thomas each had three hits in three times at bat in the second game. Sarron, whose hitting before today had not lived up to its reputation, had two doubles, two singles and a home run in seven trips, driving in six runs.
