He fanned 13 Tigers, gave no walks, and only that one hitter reached first base as FSU won 12-0. The spoiler was Auburn first

baseman Ronnie Baynes, who leveled on Stringfellow's first offering in the eighth and lined a clean single between third and short.

It was the most memorable

performance by an FSU pitcher since Tony Avitable struck out 25 Furman batters in 1956. The Seminoles had offensive fireworks galore, including shortstop Maury Hopkins' grand slam home run in the fourth, and Mike-Martin's two -- run homer in the third.
