## Seminoles Romp Over Pensacola Navy 10-1

State, with starter Steve Marks
in complete control before tiring in the eighth, jumped off
to a big six - run first inning
outburst and was never headed
in stopping Pensacola N a v y
here Friday 10-1.

Marks, who struck out four men while walking five, picked up his second victory of the year against no defeats. Eddie Howell came on in the top of the ninth to assume mound duties for the Seminoles and promptly fanned the only three men he faced.

FSU, which boosted its season record to 18-6, faces Pensacola Navy here again today at 3 p.m. CST.

Second baseman Dick Fernandez got things rolling for the Seminoles in the first stanza with a lead off single followed by Maury Hopkins' base on balls. Pete Sarron and catcher Randy Brown both singled to bring runs across for FSU.

Roy Mewbourne's base on balls loaded the sacks and set the stage for Monte McBryde. The right fielder lashed a sharp triple to right sending three Seminoles scampering across the diamond.

Gary Lawrence's sacrifice fly scored McBryde and ended the Seminoles' scoring in the first.

Coach Fred Hatfield, experimenting with the lineup after setbacks on a road trip to the Carolinas, moved Hopkins, a regular shortstop, to first and replaced him with Wayne Giardino.

Sarron, who normally holds down first for the Seminoles, went to left field and Mewbourne took over for Mike Martin, who suffered a broken right arm last week.
