Loyola Coach "Rags" Scherermann objected to the call by plate ump Walt Schenck and was ejected from the game.

Reliever Chuck Hawkins ran into trouble in the 11th and Loyola combined a walk, two singles and a double for two runs. Ken Creely came on, wild pitched one run home, walked a man, then got the last out on strikes to record his second victory of the season.

Dick Fernandez led off the fifth, Hopkins walked and scored on a single by Thomas.

Loyola came up with three runs in the eighth. Shortstop Charlie Grey, who had four hits for the visitors, tripled and came home on Don Gennusa's grounder to second.

Back to back singles by Bob Burns and Tony Blanca kept Loyola in business with two away. A wild pitch by Ranew put them on second and third and a throwing error by FSU shortstop Wayne Giardino allowed both runs to score.

Pete Sarron walked to lead off the do or die ninth for Florida State to be replaced by pinch runner Bill Bearse. In came southpaw Palazzo to face Seminole lefties Brown and Thomas. Brown dropped a perfect bunt single down first base line, and Thomas followed suit with a sacrifice which advanced Bearse to third.
