

Jim Lytle's base-loaded home run in the fifth inning yesterday gave Florida State

a 5-2 victory over the University of Mississippi at Seminole Field. It was the

Tribe's fourth straight win over the Rebels giving FSU an 11-1 season mark.

The Seminoles jumped out in front with a single run in the first on a walk to Gary Sprague, an infield out and a run scoring single by left-fielder Tom Thomas, but Ole Miss moved ahead in the third with three tallies.

Seminole starter Chester Cole issued walks to Rebel second baseman Tommy Morris and first sacker Glen Lusk, and catcher Chet Bergalowski followed with a sharp single to center. Morris, who was on second tried to score on the play, but FSU centerfielder Mike Martin's throw cut him down at home for the second out.

Yawn then boomed a triple to left that scored Lusk and Bergalowski, then Yawn scored on a wild pitch.

The Seminoles, held in check throughout the afternoon, by Ole Miss hurler Butch Lambert, took advantage of a streak of wildness by the Rebel pitcher and an error to load the bases before Lytle's blow.

Third baseman Bob Canty and pinch-hitter Randy Brown led off the fifth with walks. After pinch-hitter Maury Hopkins popped up, Gary Sprague was safe at first when Yawn booted his bouncer to short. Lytle connected on a two-two pitch and rocketed it out 330 feet over the right-center field fence.

Cole was the Seminole starter and winner, but he needed help from Marty Brooks, who limited the Mississippians to two hits over the last four innings.

FSU is now 11-1 for the year

and will meet Michigan State, coached by former Seminole mentor Danny Litwhiler, at 3 p.m. tomorrow at Seminole field in the Florida State Invitational Tournament.
