

Pete Sarron and Tom Thomas hit home runs behind the two-hit pitching of sophomore left-hander Wayne Vincent as Florida State defeated Michigan State, 5-0 here yesterday.

The Seminoles could muster only six hits — their lowest total of the year — off the pitching of Dick Holmes and ~~John Krasnan. However, that~~ was easily enough for Vincent to cruise to his third victory and second shutout.

Thomas singled to lead off ~~the second inning, and Sarron~~ lofted his second home run of the year to give the Seminoles a two-run lead.

Thomas' circuit blow came from the leadoff slot in the fifth inning. Then the Seminoles went on to get two more runs on Gary Sprague's bases-loaded single to right center.

Sarron was hit by a pitch following Thomas, then Mike Martin and Vincent singled the bases loaded. Sprague's blow ~~brought home Sarron and Mar-~~lin.

Michigan State's two hits were prodigious ones. John Biedenbach slammed a double down the rightfield line in the fourth, and Bob Speer lined a triple over Martin's

head in center in the seventh.

Only two other Spartans reached first base — both by walks, and one of them was cut down trying to steal second.

Wake Forest defeated Michigan State, 7-3 in the morning game, despite home runs by John Binkowski and Steve Juday. Steve Wrenn was the winning pitcher and aided his own cause with a home run in a big five run second inning.

Wake Forest now has a 6-2 record, Michigan State is 3-5-1, and Florida State is 12-1. Rutgers joins the tournament tomorrow.
