

Sophomore lefthander Wayne Vincent struck out 20 batters yesterday as Florida State pounded Furman 15-2 for the 21st Seminole victory of the season.

Vincent, a Birmingham, Ala., lad, who stands only 5-8 and carries 165 pounds under a thatch of red hair, used a tricky curve and a deceptive fast ball to approach a single game record set by another FSU lefthander, Tony Avable in 1956.

Avable whiffed 25 batters from Furman that time.

Vincent sprinkled eight hits, three for extra bases, in going the distance for his fifth triumph against one loss. He gave up five bases on balls.

The Seminoles unleashed a

17 - hit attack, including two home runs.

FSU beat Furman twice to gain a World Series berth in last year's District 3 tournament in Gastonia, N. C.

Randy Brown connected for his fourth homer of the year with one on in the second, and leftfielder Tom Thomas got his sixth with one aboard in the seventh.

The Seminoles ran wild, too, finished with ten stolen bases. Gary Sprague had three thefts, Brown and Maury Hopkins two each.

Brown was the hitting star with three hits in four trips and four runs batted in. Thomas had two hits in five trips and drove in three runs. Jim Lytle slashed a triple and a

double in six times at the plate and Hopkins had two doubles in four tries.

Furman used a combination of triples and follow-up singles to score its two runs. Third baseman Tom Russell tripled to open the fourth inning, and was singled home by leftfielder Richard Godsey after Vincent struck out two batters in between.

Second baseman Dave Barksdale tripled with two out in the sixth. Then center fielder Sonny Dellinger poked a single over short to bring him home.

The two teams were scheduled to play again this afternoon at 3 p. m.
