The junior lefty whiffed 11 Loyola batters and walked two enroute to his third victory without a loss. The triumph boosted FSU's mark to 23-9.

The Seminoles took the lead in the second inning after two outs. Pete Sarron singled and stole second. The catcher's throw to second went into center field and when the centerfielder booted the ball, Sarron went all the way home.

The Tribe added three more in the fourth. Randy Brown 'led off with a single, moved to second on an infield out, to third on a single by Maury Hopkins. Both runners came home on a double by Sarron. After Mike Martin flied out, Gary Lawrence singled to score Sarron.

The final Florida State run came in the fifth on a single by Gary Sprague, base on balls to Brown, and a ground rule double by Hopkins.

Sprague, Hopkins and Sarron each collected a pair of hits to pace the Seminoles.

The Tribe was scheduled to

meet Spring Hill in Mobile today at 2:30. The two meet again Wednesday.

Bill Grey's double and Tom Geraghty's triple were the only hits Loyola could manage off Brooks. Grey was Loyola's leadoff batter and Geraghty was the no. 2 man in the lineup. The bottom seven hitters in the batting order were blanked all day by the crafty southpaw.
