MOBILE, Ala.—Florida State's big bats, comparatively idle throughout the current road trip, resumed their early season vigor here yesterday and the Seminoles defeated Spring Hill, 14-2.

A 16-hit attack — which included a home run, three triples and three doubles — gave sophomore righthander Jim Helm abundant support as he went the distance for his third victory against no defeats.

It brought the Seminole record to 25-9.

The thirt-ranked Seminoles are in Tallahassee today for class registration. Tomorrow they go to Statesboro, Ga., for games with Georgia Southern.

Jim Lyttle and Maury Honkins were FSU's leading hitters yesterday, each with three hits in five times at bat.

Randy Brown had two hits in four trips and three rbis. Mike Martin also had two hits, including a triple.

Shortstop Gary Sprague, the lightest man in the FSU batting order, for the first half of the season, has been the most consistent Seminole hitter on the road. He collected two hits yesterday, one of them his first home run of the season, a 350-foot shot to right center.

Spring Hill scored in the first inning, then added another run in the second. However, the Seminoles picked up two in the second and were off and running.
