

GAINESVILLE—The University of Florida took advantage of a lone run in the third inning and rain Saturday to register a victory over Florida State's Seminoles in a game called after six innings.

Florida pitcher Kelly Prior scored the run that provided him with his fifth win of the season against two setbacks. Prior led off the third inning with a double, was moved to third via a sacrifice bunt by Danny Orr and scored when David Hodges lofted a long fly ball to center.

Florida State had several scoring opportunities to score

but couldn't cash them in.

In the first inning Jim Lyttle singled and stole second base, but was stranded there.

In the third, losing pitcher Eddie Howell reached first on an error and Lyttle singled advancing Howell to third, but a fly out ended the threat.

Maury Hopkins stroked a triple for FSU with two men out in the fourth, but he too was stranded. The Seminoles didn't get a runner past first base after that.

The Tribe outhit the Gators 5-3 but it didn't help.

Howell struck out six and walked five as his record fell to 4-2. Florida State is now 28-10 for the season. The Tribe defeated the Gators 16-4 Friday. Florida is now 17-9 for the season.

Lyttle's two singles paced the Seminoles. The slugging sophomore finished the two game Florida series with five hits in seven times at the plate.

The Florida victory tied the race for a scholarship donated by the West St. Petersburg Exchange Club to the school winning the most athletic contests. The record this year is 6-6-2.

The Seminoles play host to Georgia Southern Monday and Tuesday afternoons. Friday the Tribe treks to Jacksonville for a game with Jacksonville University.
