Florida State southpay Marvin Stringfellow spun a sixhit shutout at Georgia Southern here yesterday as the Seminoles won their 20th game of the season, 18-0.

Stringfellow hit the first pitch over the right field fence in the second, and betterymate Randy Brown hit his fifth homer of the year, a 380foot shot to right center in the third. Both came with no runners on base and were the only extra-base hits by the Seminoles.

FSU got maximum mileage out of seven hits, and needed only two for a big six-run fifth inning.

Eagle startor Allen Simmons was plagued by wildness, and reliefer Jerry Stephens let in three runs with two walks and a hit batter. Pete Sarron and Tom Thomas helped things along with singles in the fifth. Stringfellow was in trouble over twice. Eagle rightfielder Butch Davis led off the second with a triple, but the FSU pitcher got out of the inning with two strikeouts and a fly, despite walking one other man — his only base on balls of the day.

The Eagles looked as though they would spoil the shutout again in the ninth when first baseman Leahman Stanley doubled and went to third on a wild pitch. Stringfellow got Davis on strikes, but pinchhitter Tim O'Leary hit a sharp grounder that hit third baseman Maury Hopkins in the eye for a single.

Stanley, however, did not attempt to score, and Stringfellow got the next two batters on a strikeout and fly to right. In all he struck out nine batters in posting his fifth

win against four defeats.

Hopking left the field under his own power, and seemed to be all right following his injury.

Thomas was the big run pro-L ducer for the Seminoles with two singles in five trips, driv-0 ing in three runs.
