

Alabama's Jack Glover limited Florida State to just one hit last night, but the Seminoles made it count and defeated the Crimson Tide 1-0.

Chuck Cone rapped the Tribe's lone safety to start the third inning.

The second sacker proceeded to steal second, and went to third, as Roy Mewbourne grounded out to first.

~~First baseman, Dave Cooke~~ lofted a fly to center field driving in Cone with the game's only run.

LaDon Boyd went the distance for the Seminoles for the second time in as many outings. He notched his third win of the season, without defeat.

The hard-throwing right hander gave up nine hits, but he was toughest when the pressure was on, striking out

ten and pitching out of several jams.

Boyd was in hot water from the outset as he gave up three hits in the first inning.

John Holley led off that

frame with a sharp single back through the box, and George Johnson followed with a rap to right. Holley rounded second and headed to third on the hit, but Cone's relay of right fielder Mewbourne's throw caught him by a step.

Joe McCorquodale lined a single to Cone who went far to his left to spear the ball but couldn't make the play at first.

Boyd got out of the inning, by forcing Lynn Bailey to bounce out.

Joe Goodwin was safe on a two-base hit when his hopper to third took a bad bounce to lead off the Alabama fifth.

Glover popped to short, but Holley lined his second hit to left moving Goodwin to third.

Johnson ended the rally by bouncing into a double play. Bama loaded the bases with no outs in the seventh on a single, an error on an attempted sacrifice and a hit batter.

Boyd settled down to strike out the next two men and get Traffensted to foul out.

A walk and another hit batter put runners on first and second in the eighth with no outs.

Glover kept the Seminole bats completely in check as the Tribe was able to only get four balls beyond the infield.

Florida State's record is now 9-3. The Seminoles will meet Penn State and Tulane Monday at 3 and 7:30 p.m.
