

Florida State's attack, relatively harmless much of the early season, came alive last night as the Seminoles pounded out a 10-6 decision over Tulane here in the Seminoles' baseball tourney.

The Seminoles collected 12 hits in getting their 10th triumph against three losses. Included in this outburst were five doubles.

The game was played for the most part in a sprinkling rain.

Coach Fred Hatfield's club went ahead to stay in the sixth with a three-run rally, and turned things over to reliefer Jim Helm to hold the advantage. The tall righthander worked the final three innings, allowing three hits plus an unearned run.

This afternoon at 3 the Seminoles were to take on Penn State. At 7:30 tonight, the Seminoles meet Tulane again.

For three innings last night, Tulane righthander Don Simpson didn't allow a Seminole on second base. Meantime, Tulane touched winner Linwood Garrett for a run in the first on three singles.

In the fourth, Tulane got to Garrett for an unearned marker.

The Seminoles finally went ahead to stay in the sixth with three runs.

Dick Gold led the rally with a single and was wild-pitched to second. Marvin Stringfellow walked and pinch-batter John Marson belted a run - scoring double to right. Pinch-batter Wayne Vincent fanned, but Chuck Cone's perfect squeeze bunt got the Seminoles their second run of the inning and Mike Easom's infield single provided the third run.

Easom had smacked a two-run double in the fifth. He drove in three runs for the evening.

Florida State kept pecking away at relievers Dave

Andignac and Steve Costa for more runs in the late innings. Key blows in these rallies were a pair of doubles by rightfielder Charles Whitaker. Whitaker, Easom, Lance Hitchcock and Dick Gold had two hits each for the Seminoles.
