

The unbeaten Wildcats, now 9-0 on a trip which has had them on the road for 16 days, handed the Seminoles their seventh defeat against 16 victories. The two clubs meet again this afternoon at 3 p. m. with Lin Garrett scheduled to hurl for Coach F r e d Hatfield's outfit.

Parsons got the only runs it needed in the first inning with the help of a Florida State error; one of four the Seminoles were to make during the afternoon.

A five-run explosion in the third frame put the game out of Florida State's reach and the Wildcats kept adding to the total with single tallies in the fifth, seventh and eighth.

**Southpaw** Marv Stringfellow started for Florida State and it

was apparent early that this just wasn't his day. Some sloppy fielding hurried his exit during the five-run third and Len Sullivan relieved.

Following Sullivan, Hatfield used three more hurlers, Steve Marks, Rodger Netsel and Bill Cappleman.
