Countryman, who plays center when the opponent has a left-hander on the mound, drove in three-of-the Tigers' five runs.

A four-run outburst in the first inning by Auburn put the Seminoles in a hole and Lowe didn't let them get out of it.

The only runs allowed by the strong right hander from Ocala by way of Gulf Coast Junior College in Panama City, were on a pair of solo home runs by Florida State left fielder Tom Whitaker.

Auburn's first-inning getaway was started by another Gulf Coast grad, George Simmons, who doubled to right. A second-out fly to center moved Simmons to third and he scored on a single by shortstop Scotty Long.

Right fielder Johnny

Right fielder Johnny Straiton beat out a high chopper in the infield, moving Long to second. Ray Cox then doubled home Long and Coun-

tryman brought in Straiton and Cox with a long single.

An error in the eighth by
FSU centerfielder Roy
Mewbourne put Cox on second
and Countryman promptly
scored him with another single.

Lowe struck out 12 while on the way to his fourth win without a setback. After Vincent gave up the four runs in the first he settled down and at one time retired eight in a row. The little lefty, now 4-2, picked two runners off first,
