

**NEW ORLEANS** — Mike Eason hit his third home run in four days and Jeff Hill hurled a three-hitter as Florida State yesterday completed a two-game baseball sweep over Loyola of New Orleans 5-1.

Hill didn't allow a hit until the seventh inning, despite

giving up an unearned run in the first. The victory evened his record at 1-1 and upped the Seminoles' mark to 21-9. Loyola is 9-11.

Florida State will move to Starksville, Miss., today and Columbus, Miss., tomorrow for games with Mississippi State.

The Seminoles jumped out in front in the first as leadoff batter Roy Mewbourne slash-

ed a triple and came home on Tom Whitaker's single.

Loyola came back for its only run in the bottom of the inning as Chuck Abadie led things off with a base on ball, stole second, moved to third on Billy Timken's sacrifice bunt and scored when FSU shortstop Jeff Hogan made a bad throw on Jerry Brechtel's grounder.

Florida State regained the lead for good in the fourth on singles by Dick Gold and Bob Canty, a fielder's choice and Mike English's sacrifice fly.

Hogan tripled home Canty with an insurance run in the eighth and scored himself on another sacrifice fly by English. Eason, a Tallahassee boy, ended the scoring in the ninth with a homer over the right field wall.
