

In the second game with the score tied 1-1 in the ninth frame of what was to be a seven-inning contest, Eason led off with a single and Nichols followed with a base on balls.

Starter David Kahn was pulled and replaced by Larry Sheffield who got pinch-hitter Greg Schnute to fan before catcher John Keith rapped a single to right-center scoring Eason.

Pitcher Craig Skok then laid down a perfect squeeze bunt along the first base line allowing Nichols to trot home with a second run.

The Gators had taken a 1-0 lead in the second when Harmon singled, and Jim Gruber walked. On a hit and run deal Tom Eason swung and Harmon was tossed out

at third before Eason doubled in Gruber.

In the FSU third, Keith was safe on an error, sacrificed to second by Skok and on to third on a drag bunt single by Eason. Gold then singled him across.

A clutch fielding play by centerfielder Walt Sumner put the stops to the Gators in the eighth. With two outs, McTheney had singled, stole second and went on Bloodworth's single to left,

Sumner's toss caught him at the plate.

The win upped Skok's record to 6-2. He worked eight and one-third innings and allowed four hits before Mike Slade relieved him.

Florida State ended its season 38-13 while UF wound up 28-12. The Gators finished with the upper hand in the series 3-2 and the three-game series this weekend 2-1.
