

Florida State proved you do not have to have base hits to win ball games Monday night as the Seminoles "walked" past North Carolina 5-4. The win gave the Tribe a sweep of Monday's doubleheader after a 15-6 win in the opener.

The two clubs will close out their series today at 3 p.m.

North Carolina's Greg Pavlic curtailed Florida State's attack, in the night cap, limiting the Seminoles to just two hits. Except for an eighth-inning control problem, when the Tribe tallied three runs without a hit, he might have chalked up a win.

The opener of the day-night doubleheader was the complete opposite. At times it looked like "home run derby" with four circuit clouts. The Seminoles unleashed a 16-hit

attack in that one and won going away.

Hitting stars in the first game were numerous. John Grubb, Ron Cash, Greg Gromek and Dick Nichols each had three hits for FSU.

But UNC's Eddie Hill put on the big show, going four for

five including two home runs. His production was not enough to overcome the Tribe's balanced attack, however.

The Seminoles had two homers. One by Cash and another by pinch hitter Dan

Roatche. Both came with a man on.

The Seminoles picked up three runs in the first three innings and led 3-1 in the fifth. Then they exploded for six runs on three hits and put the game out of reach.

Carl Gromek picked up his fourth win of the season, although he needed help from Al Cleveland in the seventh inning.

The Seminoles were wishing they had some of those runs and hits in the second game as they went into the eighth trailing 4-2.

North Carolina led all the way up to that point, mainly on Hill's third homer of the day — a two-run shot in the fourth — and a two-run double by John Rudisill in the seventh.

In the eighth, however, the bottom fell out for Pavlick. After getting the leadoff man to bounce out, Pavlick couldn't find the plate. He walked four straight men, forcing in one run to make the score 4-3.

Rusty Prindle came on and after getting a strikeout, he hit Cash, forcing home the tying run. Harry Saferight worked Prindle for still another walk and Dick Nichols scored for the third time, this one counting as the winner.

Pat Osburn was the winner for the Tribe, picking up his fourth victory of the season. He pitched eight innings, giving up five hits and striking out nine. He, too, had control problems as he walked eight.

Mac Scarce, making his first appearance of the year, pitched the ninth, retiring the side in order.
