MOBILE, Ala. — Pat Osburn and Gene Ammann both pitched one-hit shutouts. Saturday as Florida State swept a baseball doubleheader from South Alabama by scores of 4-0 and 11-0.

The wins gave the Seminoles a sweep of the three-game road series. The Tribe won 8-4 in a come-from-behind effort Friday and now owns a 26-2 record.

Alabama was never really in contention as the pitching and early explosiveness of the Seminoles had them in command all the way.

In the opener the Tribe racked up all its runs in the first four innings while Osburn was stopping South Alabama hitless.

Losing hurler Bob Danaher walked three of the first four men he faced, and Harry Saferight cleaned the bases with a three-run double to right field.

The Seminoles added another run in the third when Ron Cash singled and scored from second on a hit by Doug Kasimier.

Osburn wound up with a onehitter when Jaquar leftfielder Gary Olson lined a 3-2 pitch into left field to lead off the fifth.

The only other near-hit for the Mobile team came in the fourth inning on a sinking line drive off the bat of Dennis Whitehead. John Grubb made a sensational running shoe-top catch, however, and turned it into a doubleplay, catching a runner off second base.

Osburn walked just three men and struck out eight en route to his sixth victory in seven decisions.

Ammann was not quite as sharp, walking five Jaquars, and striking out only five, but he also gave up just one single.

That hit came in the sixth with two outs by pinch hitter Joe Tillman. South Alabama loaded the bases in their only threat of either game in that inning, but Ammann escaped without a run scoring.

Seminole bats, meanwhile, staked Ammann to an early 5-run lead as they banged out 15 hits. The Tribe scored twice in

the first on a two-run triple by Ron Cash, and added three more in the third.
