

Not much offense was generated in the second contest, which featured two well-matched hurlers, the Jaguars' Bob Danaher and FSU's Mike Slade.

The final outcome, however, was left up to the relievers for both sides.

South Alabama registered a score in the sixth to break the ice, using two singles and a

walk. Florida State countered in the bottom of the same inning on a base on balls, two base hits and a sacrifice fly by Ron Cash.

The Jaguars evened things up in the ninth, the first time this season that the Tribe has been scored upon in this inning, helped by two errors of Mac Scarce.

This set the stage for the tenth inning dramatics.

Shortstop Greg Gromek fielded a ground ball and tossed it erratically to first sacker Doug Kasimier. While Kasimier groped for the ball, the runner, Dennis Whitehead obstructed him and then tried for second. The obstruction allowed Gary Schreiner on second base via a double, to score what appeared to be the winning run.

Meanwhile Whitehead was called out at second, the only play Kasimier had left.

Vehemently protesting that Whitehead had interfered with Kasimier, the Seminoles succeeded in getting the run nullified, which recalled Schreiner to third and declared Whitehead out at first.

After the Seminoles had finished their turn at bat in the tenth, the game was abruptly called for what later turned out to be the curfew.
