

Freshman Marty Rice pitched the first complete nine-inning game for Florida State since the FSU Invitational Tournament as the Seminoles knocked off Stetson University 2-0 Friday night at Seminole Field.

The Seminoles, winners of four straight, face the Hatters in a rematch this afternoon, then play Georgia Southern at 6:30 in a twi-light doubleheader.

Rice pitched his second shutout of the season, holding Stetson to just two-hits while picking up his eighth win in nine decisions. Only two runners reached scoring position against the right-hander.

Herb Sikes, a teammate at Tallahassee Leon High, stroked a two-out single in the fourth. He was moved to third by the second of three Ken Doria singles. Doug Kasimier scored him with a single to center.

Lorenzo Mall sparked the most serious Stetson threat by getting a leadoff double in the top of the sixth. He was moved

to third by Roy Tanner, but was stranded as Rice got the next two men on infield outs.

FSU got an insurance run in the eighth when Dave Nichols led off with a walk, stole second and went to third on an error by catcher Ralph Edwards. Ron Cash knocked him in with a single.

Ken Doria sparked the

Seminole attack by going three-for-three. Cash got two hits including a double.

Tallahassee's Chuck Bailey, former Leon High and Tallahassee Community College ace, was a standout in the field for Stetson.

Jim Durkin started for the Hatters, giving up six hits and one run while taking the loss.
