Florida State's Seminoles, in two tightly-pitched contests, divided a pair of games between two schools Saturday at Seminole Field, winning 1-0 over Stetson and dropping a 2-1 decision to Georgia Southern.

The first game of Saturday's unusual split-team doubleheader found the Seminoles taking their second straight shutout win over

Stetson.

Ron Cash delivered a sacrifice fly to deep right field in the sixth, sending Dave Nichols home with the game's only run.

As was the case Friday night when FSU's Marty Rice and the Hatters' Jim Durkin hooked up, another fine pitching duel was witnessed by the crowd.

This time it was Barry McQueen for the Tribe and John Fischetti for Stetson.

Ron cash delivered a sacrifice fly to deep rightfield in the sixth, sending Dave Nichols home with the game's only run.

As was the case Friday night when FSU's Marty Rice and the Hatters' Jim Durkin hooked up, another fine pitching duel was witnessed by the crowd.

This time it was Barry McQueen for the Tribe and John Fischetti for Stetson. McQueen picked up his third win in five decisions for FSU. The junior righthander went the distance, giving up just four hits. The Gulf Coast JC transfer had a couple of shaky moments early, but escaped unscathed.

In the second inning a pair of hits and a walk loaded the bases, but with two outs, Lorenzo Moll bounced to first.

An inning later the Hatters had runners at first and third, but again the rally fell short.

McQueen allowed just three

base runners after that.

The Seminoles capitalized on their only real threat of the game.

Nichols, who had three of FSU's five hits off Fischetti, singled and stole second. He went to third on a fly ball off the bat of Ken Doria and scored on Cash's belt to the fence in right.

The Seminoles did not fare so well in the second game against Georgia Southern. Although the pitching was strong behind Bill Fuller's 12 strikeouts and reliever Mac Scarce's three, Georgia Southern starter and winner Kyle Young was just as effective in working to his sixth win.

Young aided his own cause at the plate in the fifth inning, when the Eagles scored all their runs, cracking a long triple to centerfield to score Steve Moening who had just added an RBI with a single.

FSU's only scoring occurred in the first inning, when Cash powered a drive to right center that cleared the fence with feet

to spare.

Both teams recorded five hits in the pitcher's duel, which saw no bases on balls recorded. Fuller, at one stretch, sent five straight

batters back to the bench on strikeouts.

Florida State had the tying run on second base in scoring

position in the eighth and ninth innings, but was unable to put together a scoring combination.

Young's record is now 6-1, and Fuller absorbed his second loss of the season against five wins.
