## Jones gets victory in FSU sweep

Florida State's baseball team, shortly after recieving word that it had moved into the No. 2 spot in the collegiate rankings, swept a doubleheader from Niagara University at Seminole Field Wednesday afternoon.

In winning the first game 4-3, the Seminoles actually picked up what may be a double victory even if the latter was a moral one. The Tribe also came back to take the nightcap 13-4.

The Seminoles' moral victory came when Larry Jones drew his first start in almost a month and, after being touched up for three runs in the first inning, settled down to pitch a strong seven innings.

Meanwhile, his teammates waited until the last inning to generate enough offensive punch to hand Jones his fifth win of the season against only one defeat.

Down 3-2, the Seminoles loaded the bases with no outs in the bottom of the seventh and Niagara lefty Mike Foster, who had pitched brilliantly up to that point, proceeded to walk in the tying run.

Chip Bifano then lofted a sacrifice fly to right that plated the winning tally.

The second game was a little easier for the Seminoles, who raised their record to 32-7 on the year.

After falling behind 4-1 after three innings, Florida State exploded for four runs in the fourth and took the lead for good on a run-scoring single by Bifano with two outs in the inning.
