Seminoles top Southern 6-3

Democrat sports writer STATESBORO, Ga. — The baseball game was a little closer than the home run hitting contest, but Florida State came out the victor in both against Georgia Southern here Sunday afternoon.

After crushing the Eagles in a pre-game long-ball show, the Seminoles raised their record to 14-5 with a 6-3 victory in the ball game.

Senior righthander Larry Jones picked up his fifth win of the year without a defeat, but had to leave the game in the sixth inning after being struck in the shoulder by a line drive off the bat of Eagle third baseman Jimmy Mathews.

The injury is not serious, and Jones is expected to be ready to pitch when the Seminoles head for a tournament in Hawaii next week.

In the pre-game contest, between a coach and a player representative from each team, FSU's Woody Woodwa.d and Joe Hicks crushed the Georgia Southern pair of coach Roger Smith and Mathews 21-4.

But when the game got started, the Eagles started hitting the ball, tagging three hits of Jones in the first inning.

With the score tied 1-1 in the third, the Eagles scored a pair on a walk, a single, an error by leftfielder Jim McArdle and a wild pitch.

The Seminoles finally came untracked in the sixth when they batted around and put five runs on the board. Guillermo Bonilla had a two-

run double, and Terry Kennedy also doubled in a run.

The Eagles threatened in the bottom of the inning, but were unable to score a run despite a single and a double.
