

## Seminoles Rout Troy

TALLAHASSEE, Fla. — Florida State University parlayed three home runs into an 8-0 victory here Tuesday night as the Seminoles snapped a 10-game Troy State University baseball winning streak.

Florida State, 15-5, got single runs in the first and second innings and then exploded for six runs in the third to salt away the victory.

FSU's first homer was a solo shot by Mark Coulter in the second. Guillermo Bonilla slammed a three-run shot to key to third-inning uprising and Coulter added a two-run blast.

All three homers came off Trojan reliever Timmy Long, who came in after Jerry Gray put the first two men on base.

Troy was limited to five hits by Seminole starter Carey Brooks, who fanned 12 in eight in-

nings before being relieved by Mark Gilbert.

Both Troy losses have come to Division I schools. The first loss was the season's opener to Jacksonville, Fla., U.

The two teams conclude the two-game series Wednesday at 3:30.
