

Seminoles tune for Florida; rip Monarchs twice

ST. LEO — By all appearances, Florida State should be ready for the Florida Gators today, coming off a 9-5, 9-1 sweep of St. Leo Friday afternoon.

The Seminoles, who face the fourth-ranked Gators tonight in Gainesville and Sunday at 1:30 p.m., got their bats in tune while whipping St. Leo for the second and third times this season.

Supplying the punch for the 25-7 Seminoles were David Mobley, who homered in both games to push his season total to four; Carlos Lezcano, who ripped two triples and scored seven times; and Terry Kennedy, who drove in five runs on four hits.

Meanwhile, out on the mound neither Brooks Carey or Mike Bretz had much trouble containing the Mon-

archs, and relief pitcher Jim Miller put in a little time in each game to polish off St. Leo.

FSU had a typical start in the nine-inning opener, scoring first on an RBI double by Kennedy. A two-run homer by Mobley in the second highlighted a four-run uprising and a bases-loaded three-run double by Kennedy pushed to total to eight by the fourth inning.

Guillermo Bonilla finished the scoring in the ninth with an RBI double.

Though Bretz allowed four runs in his seven innings pitched, only one was earned, and his only trouble came against designated hitter Pete August, who went four-for-four and wound up with a perfect six-for-six afternoon.

The Seminoles again struck early in the seven-inning second game, getting the first run on a Lezcano triple and a Bonilla sacrifice fly.

In the second FSU added the only other run it needed as Ben Curry walked, moved up on a Mobley single and scored on a deep Bob Benda grounder to second.

In the third Kennedy collected his fifth RBI, driving in Lezcano, and then in the sixth the Seminoles erupted on a two-run homer by Mobley, a bases-loaded triple by Lezcano and a run-scoring single by Bonilla.

The only St. Leo run came on a solo homer by Bryan D'Ayett in the sixth as Carey easily moved his record to 4-2. Bretz pushed his record to 5-2 with the win in the opener.
