Mobley key, Seminoles win in 12th

TAMPA — David Mobley drilled a two-run home run in the top of the 12th inning here Sunday to give Florida State an 8-6 victory over South Florida.

Now 29-9 on the season, the Seminoles battle fifth-rated Miami tonight at 7:30 on the Hurricanes' Mark Light Field. Lefthander Jackie Smith, used primarily as a reliever this season, will make his second start of the year for FSU.

Mobley's homer came after Terry Kennedy had led off the 12th with a double to right. The home run was Mobley's seventh of the season, and fifth in the last eight days.

LARRY JONES, who came on in the seventh inning, picked up the win for the Seminoles. He's now 7-2 on the year, and has pitched eight scoreless innings since being relegated to the bullpen for this road trip.

The Brahmans, now 21-23, jumped on FSU starter Joe Nichols with Chuck Janson's solo homer in the first inning, then added three more in the second.

Five straight singles and an error on FSU rightfielder Chip Bifano allowed two runs to score and chased Nichols, Dave Bedingfield came on and got Dave May to pop up to end the inning.

The Seminoles had scored four in the top of the second. After Kennedy was hit by a pitch, Mobley doubled and Kennedy scored on Jim McArdle's sacrifice fly. Two walks and an error loaded the bases before Bob Benda lashed a triple, scoring three.

Florida State added a run in the third on back-to-back doubles by Kennedy and Mobley, and another in the sixth when Rick McGlone singled, Benda doubled and Carlos Lezcano scored McGlone on a sacrifice fly. THE BRAHMAN'S got to Bedingfield in the bottom of the sixth to score twice and tie it at 6-6. An error on second baseman Greg Jones and Scott Miller's double put runners on second and third, and Mark Simon followed with a triple to score two.

Then Larry Jones and South Florida's Mark Moore, who pitched the complete 12 innings, settled down until the Seminoles erupted in the

12th. South Florida threatened briefly in the bottom of the 12th when Jones walked two before striking out Simon to end the game.
