Carey hurls 'Noles past South Florida

TAMPA — Brooks Carey pitched a four-hitter Friday night as Florida State's seventh-ranked baseball team whipped South Florida 5-1. The Seminoles, now 25-4 on the year, play South Florida again this afternoon at 1:30 in Tampa.

USF took an early lead when it scored in the second inning, but Carey settled down, allowing only two baserunners after the third inning and retiring 19 of the final 21 batters while going the distance for FSU. The victory upped Carey's record to 6-0 for the season. Seminole shortstop Bob Benda collected three hits while centerfielder Mark Gilbert scored three runs.

The Seminoles trailed until the third inning when they pushed across

their first run. They scored a solo run in each of the next two innings and added two insurance runs in the ninth to seal the victory.

Mark Moore started on the mound for the Brahmans and was doing well until forced to leave the game in the fourth inning. At the time, the score was tied 1-1 and a runner was on first base. That runner eventually scored and Moore was charged with the loss. Moore's record slipped to 2-2 on the year while USF dropped to 12-10-1.
