Dolphins knock off Seminoles

JACKSONVILLE - A golden opportunity ended in disaster for the Florida State baseball team here Saturday, and with that missed opportunity came an eventual 4-3 Jacksonville victory, handing the Seminoles a rare defeat. FSU, now 29-6, lost more than a game against Jacksonville. It also lost a third baseman - a .380-hitting third baseman. The Seminoles were threatening in the top of the fourth inning and alfready had one run home when Doug Casey tried to score from second on a Mark Gilbert single to center. But Casey was cut down at the plate with the run that proved the difference. Casey came away from the collision at home with a broken arm and Jacksonville, now 29-12, came away with a win.

Don Milner started off the top of the fourth with a solo homer for FSU. Seminole starter and loser, Jim Riley (4-2), was battered for six hits and four runs in the first four innings. He went the distance, however, and did not allow a hit after the fourth frame. JU collected three runs in the second with the big blow a two-run double by Joe DelSardo — the same fellow who nailed Casey with his throw from centerfield.

Jacksonville scored the winning run in the fourth on an error and a ground ball.

FSU and Jacksonville play again today at 1 p.m. with the game to be broadcast by WGLF. Lefthander Brooks Carey (7-0) will be on the mound for the Seminoles.
